CCRSPA MINUTES - March 22, 2022

Cecil RSPA Executive Meeting 3/22/2022

We began the meeting with a discussion of meeting dates for the 2022-2023 year.

Discussion of the proposed budget:

There are a few changes that need to be made. We have promised to give \$500 to Dolly Parton's Imagination Library. It does not show up in the budget. Perhaps we need an expense line for "projects". We expanded our scholarship budget last year to include three \$1,000 scholarships and three \$200 mini grants. This number was cut and should not be. So far this year, Charlene has only received 1 application, but the deadline has not been reached. Even though Kathy has done the decorations and favors for the luncheons, she has not turned in receipts. Is there a line item to cover the cost? We have a line item for "Gifts" which shows that \$41.80 has been spent. What was that for?

We propose that the cost for lunches be raised to \$30 beginning in May, but we would like to try to stay a bit under that for the actual cost, hoping to have money to help with the cost of guests. We would like to provide a meal like we had in December – more of a dinner if we can.

We cannot raise dues and lunches this spring, but dues should be raised for the 23/24 year.

We feel that the budget should indicate taking from our reserves to balance this coming year's budget.

Discussion about donations for the May 17th luncheon:

In view of the changes with AGAPE, we are requesting donations to kid's fund or Scholarships. Paula will make sure there is a specific list in the Chalkboard and Shirley will send out an e-mail blast. There will be a display set up to show our various projects at the luncheon created by Betsy.

Legislative update:

Linda shared a summary of the legislative concerns that she will also share with the members at the luncheon.

Healthcare:

Paul has a meeting on 3/23. It was brought up that the AETNA insurance does not pay for rehabilitation care at any of the quality choices here in Cecil County where Blue Cross does. Paul will ask about this at the meeting.

At the Wednesday meeting, Paul brought up concerns about rehab care being limited to lower quality care by AETNA. Committee said that didn't sound right. Anyone with a concern should contact AETNA.

Recognition by MRSPA:
