CCRSPA MINUTES – September, 2022

The group gathered at 11:00 AM at Elkton United Methodist Church. President Anne Humphrey called the meeting to order at 11:17 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

First time attendees were: John Mazurick, Katharine Mazurick, Becca McCall, and Allison McMann.

Anne stated that being a member of MRSPA is an insurance policy for our pension. MRSPA is standing up for us and helping to protect our pensions.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

<u>Treasurer's report</u> - Tony Mattern said the organization has approximately \$20,000 in a CD and checking account. It is still early in the year. He reminded us that we are a tax exempt organization and if anyone is making any purchases for the association to please use the tax exempt number.

Benefits - Paul Humphrey said he would be attending a meeting during the third week of October.

<u>Community Outreach</u> - Paula Cobb Sheldon and Kay DiStefano have been doing a wonderful job purchasing items for seventeen schools. Paula thanked everyone that brought in donations to the meeting. She said the nurses were very appreciative of what we are doing. She announced that Tony Mattern will be honored at the Maryland Senior Citizen Hall of Fame luncheon on October 20, 2022. The luncheon is being held at Ten Oaks Ballroom in Clarkville, MD.

Constitution - no report

Consumer Education - Tony Mattern stated that information can be found on our webpage.

<u>Legislation</u> - Linda Elwood participated in a ZOOM meeting on August 16. The group reviewed legislative priorities. The main focus was on our pensions. Some states are taking pensions away from the teachers. Legislative meetings will begin again on January 17, 2023. Meetings will be held the first and third Thursday of every month. Please think about joining the Legislation Committee.

<u>Membership</u> - Sherry Lewis said we have 269 members. Her goal is for us to have 280 members. Sherry said not as many people are retiring from CCPS. They are leaving the county before they are of retirement age.

Nominating - Anne said we need a nominating chairperson. We also need a president. This is definitely Anne's last meeting as president. Please think about being president or co-president. Some of the responsibilities of the president are: attend two state meetings, complete an end-of-year report, preside over our executive board meetings and our meetings. We are also in need of a recording secretary, social chairperson, assistant treasurer, and an assistant webmaster. Please consider stepping into one of these positions.

<u>Publications</u> - Gretchen Ginder wants all information for the Chalkboard by November 8. Our next luncheon is scheduled for December 6. We are down to 107 newsletters being mailed.

Scholarship Committee - Marie Madron announced that teachers have received the information for mini-grants. All applications are due by October 15. Our organization will be granting three \$200.00 grants. The money must be used for a project/supplies/equipment that is not provided by the BOE, must benefit the students, and must be used in the classroom this year. At the end of the year the teacher needs to send us a write-up and pictures of the project so the committee can display the information. The scholarship committee will also be awarding scholarships in the spring to three CCPS graduates that are entering their junior or senior year of college and majoring in education.

Social Committee - 46 folks signed up for today's luncheon. In the past we have averaged 60 - 70 attendees. Your Personal Chef from Rising Sun is doing the catering for today's luncheon. A location has not yet been set for the holiday luncheon in December. Travel - Fred Metzger shared a lot of information about the Alaska trip. The group of twelve departed Philadelphia with temperatures close to 100'. The next day in Fairbanks, they could see their breath. They had snow in Denali. They did a 43 mile bus trip through Denali. Some of the things they saw were: sled dogs, grizzly bears, elk, tarragon, the backend of a moose, whales breaching, and a Native American Museum. At Hubbard Glacier they could hear the ice cracking. At Icy State Point they saw several whales, one of the oldest is named Frederick. The food was delicious and they all had a wonderful time. Hill Travel is donating \$179.00 to our scholarship committee.

<u>Program Committee</u> - Mary McCleary announced Mary Ann Jung would be performing a Living History program of Dr. Sally Ride - Reach for the Stars. A high school group will be performing for our December luncheon. Mary also thanked everyone that provided items for today's raffle.

<u>Sunshine Committee</u> - Please let Debbie Pasco know of any members that are ill so she can send them a card. The meeting was adjourned at 12:03 PM.


